



#### **CHURCH OPPORTUNTIES**

MARCH MISSION FOCUS: "MONUMENTAL FAITH" We can help it to grow. In Espanola, NM, this summer some children will be enriched by 6 weeks of "Camp Stars," a program of McCurdy Ministries which is our March Mission Focus. Each week, 50 children (K thru 6th) will learn about God's awesome creations that surround the area, along with Bible School lessons and STEM education. Field trips are scheduled to nearby Ghost Ranch, Rio Grande Gorge, Los Luceros Historic Ranch, and several Pueblo archaeological ruins.

Most of the students are from low-income families and will only be able to participate if they receive scholarships. WE CAN HELP! At a cost of \$200 per child [for camp supplies, 2 meals per day and transportation], how many children can we sponsor? You may contribute with a check to Central UMC, designated "McCurdy" or with coins or cash on Sundays.

**SO MUCH LOVE!** Joyce Rockwell and Joyce Witt delivered 632 "Bundles of Love" (underwear and socks) for students of Mitchell HS. Swigert MS and Wilson Elementary. The community liaisons who received our gifts were extremely grateful.

WALKING TO JERUSALEM: We reached Dakar, the capital of Senegal, West Africa, a country where 95% of the people are Muslim yet their president is Catholic. The ethnic majority are Wolof though French is the official language. We saw many beautiful mosques and minarets topped with green orbs. We experienced an emotional visit to the House of Slaves, a museum and memorial for the processing center used for the slave trade to the Americas. After our lion encounter at the Fathala Wildlife Reserve, we feasted on thieboudienne (fish and rice), the national dish of Senegal. Dakar will host the youth Olympic games in 2026, the first time the games will be played on the African continent.
