JANUARY MISSION FOCUS: Kutela Katembo is accomplishing great things through his ministry as an agriculturist at the Kessua Mission in Angola. A second concrete fish pond has been built this year. And now, they have started raising pigs!! From the beginning, livestock husbandry has been a dream and target for the farm, and through your support they are realizing it. In October they were able to purchase two pigs! Pigs reproduce 3 times a year, so this project is growing rapidly. It’s clear that the money you have contributed is helping in very real and practical ways.
