2 Samuel 6:1-5

He and all his men went to Baalah in Judah to bring up from there the ark of God, which is called by the Name, the name of the Lord Almighty, who is enthroned between the cherubim on the ark. They set the ark of God on a new cart and brought it from the house of Abinadab, which was on the hill. Uzzah and Ahio, sons of Abinadab, were guiding the new cart with the ark of God on it, and Ahio was walking in front of it. David and all Israel were celebrating with all their might before the Lord, with castanets, harps, lyres, timbrels, sistrums and cymbals.”

“So David went to bring up the ark of God from the house of Obed-Edom to the City of David with rejoicing. When those who were carrying the ark of the Lord had taken six steps, he sacrificed a bull and a fattened calf. July Mission Focus: !Fun Surprises for Special Kids! In early August the staff of La Puente Social Services in Alamosa, CO, will be giving out 600 BACKPACKS filled with school supplies to low-income children at several sites throughout the San Luis Valley. They have received a grant that will provide all the school supplies and backpacks, which is what we usually donate. So, here's what they need, and it's so much fun!! We get to buy stickers and markers and crackers and juice!

With the grant money, La Puente will also purchase a metal water bottle for each child because the school drinking fountains will be turned off this fall as a COVID precaution. They've asked if we might contribute Sharpies Metallic-Colors Permanent Markers to write each child's name on a bottle, stickers so the kids can 'decorate' their bottles and school supplies, plus Gold Fish Crackers in individual packets and juice boxes/pouches. The juice and crackers will be distributed as the children are standing in long lines waiting to receive backpacks. This is not superfluous silliness. This is helping 600 children living in poverty to enjoy a super-fun experience as they receive their backpacks and water bottles. Please bring stickers or markers or crackers or juice to the basket in the entryway any time during July. Bob and Madellen will deliver our gifts after July 25th.
